Car has two generators, two heating system for BACKUP and it is fully air conditioning for comfort. It also has a 10 ton compressor and an 8 ton condenser and EVAP-COILS, 2-stage system, first stage and second stage.

Car has an open observation area with a dining room which can be used for a small party setting, meeting-room, business type setting, or a large family gathering. The wood type setting in the car showcases the elegant beauty of the interior of the car with it lighting arrangements with the mirror in the background. The blind provides the setting for private events or a public viewing. The arrangement of the furniture will provide a view to all the events, actions, and are great for private settings. The observation deck is fully lighted, and it has the comfort of viewing the sunset or sunrise with an open view with handrails for protections with standing area.

NOTE: The color scheme of the interior has matched the carpet to give a warm feeling and a welcoming atmosphere to all aboard. This car is one of the best looking, well-kept and updated of the fleets of private cars that travel on Amtrak all over the USA and Mexico.

Car is equipped with side arm shocks for a smoother ride around the turns and uneven tracks. Car is equipped with Track Lights, Mars light.

NOTE: Track Lights can be remotely controlled as well as the lightening system in the observation end of the car's dining areas.

NOTE: Car has a circular logo display on observation end/platform. Car is equipped with both brake pipe & main reservoir pipes. B.P-90 LBS, MR130.

Car has a master B/Room (D) with a Q-Bed and lots of storage areas under bed & above with a closet, a washroom, sink and shower.

NOTE: Washroom can be shared by room (C). Room (C) has 2 Bunk Beds.  
Room B has 2 Bunk Beds and Room (A) has 2 Bunk Beds with it's own toilet.  
NOTE: Car has a large room with toilet and sink for public use.

Car has a self-contain kitchen with all modern equipment within hand reach.  
For an efficient chef e.g. refrigerator and freezer compressors/ condensers have been placed under the car to reduce heat inside the galley.

NOTE: Car has a dishwasher in the kitchen next to the sink, an electric stove, a microwave oven, a wine chiller, and lot of storage areas. It' a chef's dream kitchen.


NOTE: This car has a washer and dryer in the rear of the car to reduce noise and a huge water storage tank under the car with a fast recovering hot water system. It can sustain up to 12 people for a party or a family of 8 or 6 guests, 1 mechanical personnel and 1 chef.

NOTE: This car has a satellite dish on top of the car for TV and WIFI. Also, it has a 2-way radio system to communicate with railroad personnel.

NOTE: A car of this caliber with all the updating and backing up of systems is a private car owner's dream. The Silver Foot is a trend setter and is above all in its class of business cars. I can say this as a railroader and a passenger that this car outshines the rest by far in my 45 years in the railroad industry.

This car is worth over \$800,000 plus or more in today's car market. It's an American classic.
